



Dear Prostate Health Screening Participant:

This is your voucher to participate in St. Clair Hospital's Prostate Screening. This screening consists of two parts - a blood test (PSA) and a digital exam by a physician.

1. Prior to your digital exam, you must have a blood test (PSA). It should be done before **September 25, 2009** in order for the results to be available on your appointment day. Please note: We have **3 locations** for you to choose from for your blood work. No appointment is necessary.

2. Please remember to bring your consent form with you for your blood test. The lab person will keep this and forward your results to the coordinator of the screening. **No results will be given over the phone.**
3. During your appointment the physician or Physician Assistant will review the results of your blood test and perform a digital rectal exam. You will be given the assessment and recommendations for follow-up, if necessary.
4. When you called for this screening, you were given a time to appear for your digital exam by the physician. **The screening will take place at St. Clair Hospital Outpatient Center Bethel Park located at 2000 Oxford Drive. Please make note of the date and time.**
